













The second ordinary session of the Reinsertion Commission in Cuauhtemoc was held on May 4th in the local FICOSEC offices. During the meeting, a variety of important topics related to reinsertion were discussed; also, CCSJ offered training to the institutions that participate in the Commission in order to raise awareness among their staff and ensure good practices during the implementation of the model.

Some of the actors that participate in the Cuauhtemoc Commission are: FICOSEC, Center for Primary Attention of Addictions, State Human Rights Commission, State Supreme Court and the following Local State Prosecutor's Office departments: Coordination of Judicial Measures for Minors in Conflict with the Law, Coordination of Victim Assistance, and the Coordinator of the Center of Observation, Classification and Treatment of CERESO Nº 7 inmates.



Staff training on psychometric and projective psychology tests.

The Council's staff received training on the application of the PCL-R Projective Test (Psychopathy Checklist Revised). The course consists of four sessions of which three have already taken place, the fourth will be held on May 20th.

This test will be an important tool to get information about the participant's behaviors, lifestyle, and interpersonal and affective deficits.

On May 10th Mother's Day is celebrated in Mexico and for that reason the participants who take guitar lessons prepared and presented a song during a Family Enrichment workshop where family members (mostly mothers) and support networks of the young participants attend. After the presentation a small gathering took place with families, participants and staff members.
