COLLABORATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CCSJ.

The Direction of the local Police Department and CCSJ Chihuahua signed a collaboration agreement last Friday, March 16th. The purpose of this agreement is to achieve the joint collaboration pro social reinsercion of youth in conflict with the law, whom will be referred from the Police Department to the program "We Believe in You" from the Citizen Council.

WORKSHOP: "THERAPEUTIC APPROACH TO THE SUICIDE RISK"

Operative personnel from CCSJ Chihuahua attended the workshop "Therapeutic Approach to the Suicide Risk", imparted by Dr. Luz de Lourdes Eguluz and organized by the Preventive Psychology Attention Center (CAPSI), with the purpose of training the team and acquiring tools that could be used on the prevention of risk in suicidal behaviors from the participants of We Believe in You.

TRAINING TO THE COURT FOR ADDICTION TREATMENT IN CUAUHEMOC.

A training was imparted for the personnel of the Court for Addiction Treatment (TTA) in Cuauhtemoc. The Court will begin duties soon in this locality. Within the training, a simulation of a pre-hearing and a hearing of a participant was performed, courtesy of the team from TTA Chihuahua, where CCSJ participates. Later, some study cases were given to the team from Cuauhtemoc so they were able to perform their own simulation. With this task, they were able to practice the procedures, with their respective feedback from Judge Rogelio Guzman, state coordinator of TTA.
