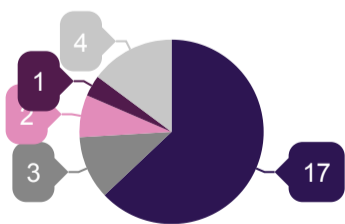
"SUICIDE CONDUCT DETECTION AND PATIENT CHANNELING IN COMORBIDITY WITH ADDICTION" TRAINING.

TRAINING TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ROAD SECURITY IN NUEVO CASAS GRANDES PERSONNEL

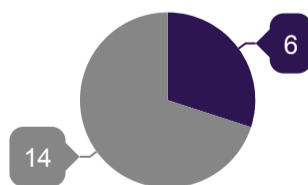

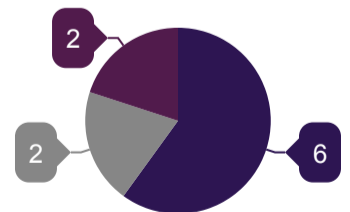
